Overview

This course is aimed at candidates that require the knowledge and practical skills operate Road Rollers to compact a variety of ground.

Entry Requirements

NPORS CSCS – Candidates must have achieved the relevant CITB Health, Safety & Environment (HS&E) touch-screen-test within 2 years.

Good understanding of spoken and written English.

Course Content

- Understand the industry, the dangers of working in the industry and their responsibilities as an operator
- Understand the manufacturer's handbook for the particular machine to be used
- Locate and identify the major components of the machine and explain their functions
- Locate and identify key controls and explain their functions
- Conduct all pre-operational checks in accordance with manufacturer's and legislative requirements
- Identify and maintain PPE appropriate for roller use
- Prepare the roller for use and operate machinery safely and efficiently
- Conduct all necessary safety checks at the work area
- Operate machinery safely and efficiently
- Understand environmental considerations
- Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of loading and unloading procedures for machine transportation
- Carry out all end of shift and shut down procedures

Assessment

- Novice - Three (3) Days – Classroom-based and Practical Training and testing
- Experienced Worker Tests - One (1) Day – Theory and Practical Tests

Certification

Successful candidates will be issued with an NPORS Traditional Operator card (valid for 5 years) or an NPORS Red Trained Operator card (valid for 2 years).

Grants

CITB grants are available - please speak to one of our team for further information.

Next Steps

NPORS Traditional Card – There are no requirements to complete an NVQ, a five year card is issued and after five years reassessment is required.

To upgrade your card to Blue, you will need to complete the Level 2 NVQ Certificate in Plant Operations – Compacting and an Operatives Health, Safety and Environment Test completed within the last 2 years.
